

Town Board Meeting – Town of Hammel – February 10, 2026

The town board meeting was called to order by Chairman Joe Zenner at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 10, 2026 at the Hammel town hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. All board members were present with the exception of Mike Ecklund.

The minutes of the January 13, 2026 town board meeting were reviewed. Supervisor Zenner made a motion to approve the minutes. Supervisor Emmerich seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The treasurer's report was given. Supervisor Zenner made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Supervisor Emmerich seconded the motion. Motion carried.

In open discussion resident Jack Johnson inquired about the progress of the Center Avenue project as many residents are asking. At this time, there is nothing to report. No decisions have been made on the awards. The plan is, if we are awarded the LRIP money, 2 miles of Center Avenue will be paved in 2027 and dust control applied. If we do not get the award, one mile of Center Avenue will be paved.

Brad reported that the roads are in fairly good condition until the wind came up today. Brad put up a new flag. Gravel budget for next year was reviewed as Brook Drive needs some gravel.
